FIGHT FOR IMPROVED HEALTH CARE

There is a clear need to improve health provision in Haverhill and surrounding villages, including the case for a new or expanded health centre and more local outpatient services.



WORKING WITH PARTNERS FOR A NEW "BLUE LIGHT HUB" FOR HAVERHILL

A Blue Light Hub would provide upgraded facilities for emergency services, helping support a growing town and improve response times. We are working initially to help bring together the ambulance and police services with the potential to add the fire service later.



FIGHT TO KEEP LIBRARIES OPEN

Libraries are so important as social hubs. So many clubs depend on them. They must remain open. I will use my experience to protect them at all cost as I have done before.



CONSERVATIVE TEAM SUCCESS

The Conservatives led on getting the Haverhill North West relief road opened. The new waste centre in Haverhill. Introduction of one hour's free parking (software being updated). Fought off the Spring Grove anaerobic digester. Improvements to the high street, with more to come.
